### 2 PLANNING:

#### 2.1 Applications:

**13/00730/FUL** Basketmakers Cottage, Wick Lane, Apperley: Application to remove condition 2 of 10/01008/FUL to allow use as a permanent residential unit

Comments to Tewkesbury Borough Council:

The Parish Council **objects** to this application for the following reasons:

- Increased traffic on a single track road which does not have any passing places
- To gain access to the property the vehicle has to turn in the driveway opposite
- Access onto the B4213 is hazardous due to lack of visibility
- Discussions with immediate neighbours have highlighted problems with access and parking to this property since it has been a holiday let.

**13/00818/FUL** April Cottage, Deerhurst: Proposed two storey side extension and replacement outbuilding

- It had been inspected by John Hicks in respect of the ROSPA inspection and he had reported that it met the requirements.

- The Clerk had spoken to Came and Co and the insurance was activated on Tuesday, 27 August which the Clerk had raised a cheque for the period 27.8.13 to 31.5.14 for the sum of £161.24.
- He had appointed Billy Davies to carry out the weekly inspection of the track.

- A parishioner in Deerhurst was prepared to make a plastic sign for the sum of £10 – The Councillors agreed this payment.
- The Parish Council now needed to seek some funding from TBC or another outside source.
